NO₂ Monitor at Town Hall

The Town Hall monitor records the average NO₂ concentration for each hour throughout the day as an indication of the level of air pollution. The monthly average for October was 34.3 µg/m³ which is below the annual objective and is the lowest October levels in the past 4 years. This continues the pattern seen in September where again the average level was low. October was again a mild and sunny month which could explain the reduced level of pollution. The average for the year to the end of October was 37.3 µg/m³ which is slightly below the annual objective. There were no hourly exceedances during October which leaves the total at one this year, with 18 such exceedances allowed over the year.
